Financial Report: We were blessed with an anonymous non-pledged gift of \$50,000 during the month. In accordance with our Standards of Procedure \$25,000 was added to our Special Gifts Fund at TPF.

Total operating income for October was \$ 109,522 which is 25% better than plan for the month. Total income, year-to-date, is \$82,011 over plan. However, this is due in large part to a non-pledged gift of \$50,000 received in July for work on Ryan Hall. If we do not consider this Ryan Hall gift, then we are approximately \$32,030 ahead of our giving plan.

EXPENSES: Most areas continue to be under or near budget. Total operating expenses for October were \$73,303 on a plan of \$83,100. Year-to date we are \$38,398 under planned expenses.

Income was over expenses for October by \$36,219.
