Financial Report: Total income for 2022 was \$1,143,800 which is 8.7% over plan. Total 2022 expenses were \$956,073- 4% under plan. For the year income exceeded expense by \$187,727.

Deacon's Report: Their first meeting of the year was spent with organizational matters and remembering the good work of Deacon Harlan Helmers who died in December. Deacon Joyce Schlechte has agreed to take over and care for Harlan's flock for the remainder of his term in 2023.

Mission Outreach: Jane Ragsdale shared the work done by our church and our ecumenical partners in the village of Guayabales, Guatemala and surrounding villages in this most recent mission trip. **Planning & Training:** The officer retreat scheduled for Feb. 11 has been postponed until sometime after Easter.

Property reported that they are working on the installation of security lighting for the back parking lot and the choir room entrance for a cost not to exceed \$8,400.

Pastor's Report: Dr. Haberer reported on his many activities for the past two months. He encouraged everyone to be reaching out to potential new members.

Business of Church Councils:

- Commissioners to the called meeting of Mission Presbytery held on Zoom on Saturday, January 21, 2023, reported that the presbytery had its first reading of updated bylaws to match the recently approved new structure of organization. The presbytery also voted to dismiss the Island Presbyterian Church, Pt. Aransas, TX to the Evangelical Covenant of Presbyterians (ECO).
- Commissioners elected to attend the stated meeting of Mission Presbytery March 3-4, 2023, at Covenant Presbyterian Church in San Antonio, TX, <u>are B. K. Gamble, Ed Wallace, Sam Begeman,</u> and Clarice Amann. Alternate commissioner is Becca Huchton.

The following items were acted upon and approved:

- Received the report from the Pastor Nominating Committee with joy and appreciation for their service.
- Renewed the contract with Interim Pastor Rev. Dr. Jack Haberer from January 17, 2023, to May 31, 2023.
- Honored the request of <u>LouAnn Smith</u> that her name be removed from our rolls.
- Budget & Finance recommended that the \$50,000 anonymous gift discussed in November meeting be divided as follows: (\$5000 to Currie Enrichment Fund and \$5000 to be distributed by Mission Outreach—both already approved in Nov. meeting), \$25,000 to fund the 2023 Benevolences in Mission Outreach 2023 budget, and the remaining \$15,000 to be decided by Budget & Finance at a later date.
- Budget & Finance recommended the adoption of the 2023 budget.
- **Mission Outreach** requested approval for the Habitat for Humanity Task Force to raise an additional \$2000 to underwrite the cost of weekly meals to feed the Habitat workers working on "our" Habitat house.
- Youth & Young Adult: Recommended, in coordination with Shannon Tuschak, Director of Congregational Care, the possibility of bringing back All Church Dinners beginning in February, and each committee would take a month to "plan". YAYA would start on February 21st with the Pancake Supper fundraiser.
