- Easter Sunday, The Flowering of the Cross: This Easter we hope to revive a tradition formerly celebrated at FPCK: The Flowering of the Cross. This tradition can be traced back as far as the 6th century. The empty cross representing death and sadness gives way to the miracle and hopefulness of new life as evidenced in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. We invite worshipers to bring fresh flowers (from your yard or grocery store) to be inserted into an empty cross covered in damp moss. To keep your flowers fresh, please wrap them in damp paper towels or bring in a disposable cup filled with a small amount of water. We will have clippers for trimming and helpers to assist you in placing the flowers on the cross. You may also leave your flowers in a bucket of water anytime Sunday morning and we will insert them for you. After celebrating Easter Sunday at worship you may return to take pictures with your family or friends in front of the Flowered Cross. We will have helpers to snap pictures with your phones.
