Children Youth, and Young Adults: Emily reported that the youth are keeping very busy with Confirmation and continue to see great engagement. The partnership with Schreiner has taken a pause until they call a new Campus Minister. Children's Sunday school and Parent's Night Out continue to see good engagement.

Pastor's Report:

<u>Pastor Susan</u> has expressed her desire not to be a paid staff member by the end of 2024. She will take medical leave in July and return later in August in a different capacity. We are working on a transition plan that will allow for an additional Parish Associate.
